**Students enrolled in Coral Reef Montessori Academy Charter School remain active with Miami-Dade County
Public Schools and retain entitlement to all applicable policies.**

Parent Responsibilities:

Parents or family members are encouraged to complete 30 hours of volunteer service per student to benefit the school and help the child and others learn.

Parents are encouraged to ensure that their child arrives at school on time ready to learn.

Parents are encouraged to ensure that their child arrives at school wearing the appropriate school uniform (navy blue sport shirt, khaki shorts/pants/skirt, tennis shoes and socks).

Parents are encouraged to ensure that my child arrives at school each day with homework assignment completed.

Parents are encouraged to attend at least two parent-teacher conferences per school year.

Parents are encouraged to attend CRMA parent training session at the beginning of the school year.

Parents are encouraged to attend at least two open house events a year.

Parents are encouraged to attend two Montessori workshops a year.

If a conflict should arise, parents must have conflicts over the parent contract be resolved by a committee of the conflict resolution appointee, one board member and one member of the school staff.

Parents are encouraged to abide by any other rules and regulations the Committee, with approval of the Governing Board, may establish to operate the school.

Parents are required to pick up your children on time. There is a \$25.00 late fee each time you are late.

Parents are encourage to abide by the four anti bullying rules:

1. We will not bully others.
2. We will try to help students who are bullied.
3. We will try to include students who are left out.
4. If we know that somebody is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home.
